

# AAI - Dana Foundation Award in Human Immunology Research

Deadline for 2009 Nominations: Friday, November 14, 2008

## DESCRIPTION

This award recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions to the understanding of the immune processes pertinent to human disease pathogenesis, prevention, and therapy. The award recipient will receive a \$5,000 cash award and travel support to attend the AAI Annual Meeting for presentation of his or her work in an award lecture. In addition, the award provides support to one member of the awardee's laboratory to attend the AAI Annual Meeting. *This award is generously supported through a grant from the Dana Foundation.*

## ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must be Regular AAI members in good standing who have a record of significant achievement and possess the potential for sustained accomplishment in immunology research pertinent to human disease pathogenesis, prevention, and therapy.

## NOMINATION

Candidates must be nominated by a Regular AAI member in good standing. Members may not nominate themselves. Members of the AAI Council, AAI Awards Committee, and Dana Foundation Board of Directors may neither nominate or recommend candidates, nor be nominated themselves.

## NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please include the following in the nomination package:

1. A nomination letter of not more than three (3) pages, signed and submitted by a Regular AAI member in good standing, indicating the nominee's qualifications for the award. The letter should summarize the nominee's major contributions to human immunology. The nominator is required to select the nominee's five (5) most important publications relevant to the award and include a short paragraph explaining the significance and historical context of each for human immunology. Include the nominee's complete contact information (name, title and affiliation, mailing address, phone number, fax number, and e-mail address).
2. The nominee's biosketch, including education and fellowships (institutions, dates, degrees); important awards; relevant employment history; and selected bibliography with complete citations with titles.
3. One (1) additional letter of recommendation. *This letter must be signed and included in the package.*

**Complete nomination packages must be received by 5:00 PM E.S.T. on Friday, November 14, 2008.**

**Packages must be submitted in hard copy by U.S. mail or expedited mail (neither e-mails nor faxes will be accepted). Incomplete nomination packages will not be considered; AAI will not accept materials sent separately.**
