

# Pfizer-Showell Travel Award

Deadline for 2009 Applications: Monday, January 12, 2009

## DESCRIPTION

This award recognizes the professional promise of an early career investigator (assistant professor or equivalent) by assisting the award recipient with travel to the AAI Annual Meeting to present his or her research. Selection is based on career progress and submission of an outstanding abstract selected for oral presentation in a Block Symposium at the meeting. *This award is supported through an endowment from AAI member Henry J. Showell and Pfizer, Inc.*

## ELIGIBILITY

Regular AAI members in good standing who have received their advanced degree within the past 10 years and hold a position of assistant professor or equivalent, are eligible to apply for this award. Post-doctoral fellows, other trainees, and senior faculty (associate professor and above) are not eligible.

## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please include the following in the application package (*please clearly designate "Pfizer-Showell Travel Award" in the cover letter*):

1. A letter that includes the following information --
  - Name
  - Title and affiliation
  - Current mailing address, phone number, fax number, and e-mail address
2. Applicant's CV, including current funding and past AAI awards
3. A copy of the abstract submitted to the forthcoming AAI Annual Meeting
4. A brief statement of applicant's research goals (not to exceed one page)

Complete application packages must be received by 5:00 PM E.S.T. on Monday, January 12, 2009. Packages must be submitted in hard copy by U.S. mail or expedited mail (neither e-mails nor faxes will be accepted). Incomplete packages will not be considered; AAI will not accept materials sent separately.
