

Cynthia Chambers Memorial-eBioscience Junior Faculty Award

Application Deadline: **January 22, 2010**



DESCRIPTION

Established to honor the memory of AAI member Dr. Cynthia Chambers, this award is intended to advance the career of a junior scientist who attends the AAI Annual Meeting and presents an outstanding abstract specifically in the area of cancer biology. The award recipient will receive a \$1,000 cash award and a certificate during an Awards Ceremony at the AAI Annual Meeting. *This award is generously supported through a grant from eBioscience, Inc.*

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, applicants must: (1) be a **Regular AAI member in good standing***; (2) have received a doctoral degree within the past ten (10) years and/or be junior faculty (assistant professor or equivalent); and (3) have submitted a first-author abstract for presentation (oral or poster) at IMMUNOLOGY2010™ in the field of cancer-related immunology. To remain eligible for this award, applicants must also be members in good standing through 2010. Eligibility of the nominee will be checked at the time of award submission and before presentation of the award.

Please send **all** documents **as PDF files** to **awards@aai.org**. Please be aware that attachments must be no larger than 20MB. Packages that are not complete will not be considered.

Please include the following in the application package:

1. A letter clearly designating “Cynthia Chambers Memorial-eBioscience Junior Faculty Award” and including the following information —

- Full name (first, middle initial, last)
- Title and affiliation
- Current mailing address, phone number, fax number, and e-mail address
- A brief statement of applicant’s research goals (not to exceed two pages)

2. Applicant’s curriculum vitae, including current funding and past AAI awards.

3. A copy of the abstract submitted to IMMUNOLOGY2010™

Complete application packages must be received by 12 Midnight E.S.T. on January 22, 2010. Packages must be submitted by e-mail as PDF documents to awards@aai.org. A confirmation email will be sent within 72 hours of receipt. Incomplete application packages or applications that do not comply with the stated instructions will not be considered. AAI will not accept materials sent separately or through regular mail.
