AAI Summer Courses**

Travel Awards Available for Underrepresented Minority Scientists

The FASEB MARC Program is sponsoring travel awards to help support the participation of minority scientists in attending the 2006 AAI Introductory and Advanced Courses in Immunology. Underrepresented minority faculty, students, and postdoctoral fellows from majority institutions, minority institutions (MIs), historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs), and corporations are eligible to apply.

The travel awards recipients are funded up to \$1,350 each for travel-related expenses. Course registration fees are also covered by the program. Travel awards are provided as reimbursements upon successful completion of the course.

These travel awards are supported by a federal training grant from the NIGMS/NIH. Therefore, only U.S. citizens and permanent residents of the U.S. are eligible. For travel award information, please contact Trevia Jennings via email at tjennings@faseb.org.
