Careers in Immunology Fellowships	March 15	Provide member PIs with one year of salary support for a graduate student or postdoctoral fellow in their labs.	Up to \$61,996 in salary support
Intersect Fellowships for Computational Scientists and Immunologists	September 1	Support immunology researchers and computational scientists to train in each other's discipline. PIs receive one year of salary support for a postdoctoral fellow.	Up to \$61,996 in salary support
Fellowships for Career Reentry	September 1	Provide one year of salary support to postdoctoral fellows who have taken a leave of absence of one year or more due to family-related issues, medical absences, or military obligations.	Up to \$61,996 in salary support

Excellence in Mentoring Award	October 12	Recognizes a senior scientist who has significantly influenced the professional development and careers of a new generation.	Up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the AAI annual meeting
Steinman Award for Human Immunology Research	October 12	Recognizes an individual who has made significant contributions to the understanding of immune processes underlying human disease pathogenesis, prevention, or therapy. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$5,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
BioLegend Herzenberg Award	October 12	Recognizes an individual who has made exemplary research contributions to the field of B cell biology. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$5,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
Thermo Fisher Meritorious Career Award	October 12	Recognizes a mid-career scientist for outstanding research contributions to the field of immunology. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$10,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
BD Biosciences Investigator Award	October 12	Recognizes an early career investigator who has made outstanding contributions to the field of immunology. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$5,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
ASPIRE Award	October 12	Recognizes up to five outstanding early career investigators for research accomplishments and professional promise in the field of immunology. Laboratory Travel Grants	December 19	Assist mid-career and senior investigators in attending the AAI annual meeting. Each grant will also support travel costs for a lab member of the recipient's selection.	Up to \$2,500 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
Early Career Faculty Travel Grants	December 19	Assist young investigators (assistant professor or equivalent) in attending the AAI annual meeting.	Up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
Undergraduate Faculty Travel Grants	December 19	Assist undergraduate faculty in attending the AAI annual meeting. Each grant will also support travel costs for an undergraduate student of the recipient's selection.	Up to \$2,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
Trainee Abstract Awards	December 19	Recognize trainee members whose first-author abstracts submitted to the AAI annual meeting are selected for presentation in block symposia.	\$500 award
Trainee Poster Awards	December 19	Recognize trainee members whose first-author abstracts submitted to the AAI annual meeting are selected for poster sessions only and found to be exceptional by the AAI Abstract Programming Chairs.	\$300 award
Thermo Fisher Trainee Achievement Awards	December 19	Recognize up to six trainees annually for career promise and presentation of an outstanding first- author abstract selected for oral presentation in a block symposium at the AAI annual meeting.	\$1,000 award and up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
Minority Scientist Travel Awards	December 19	Assist eligible underrepresented minority scientists, including trainees and early career faculty members, in attending the AAI annual meeting.	Up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting

Lustgarten-Thermo Fisher Scientific Memorial Award	December 19	Intended to advance the career of a mid-career scientist (associate professor or equivalent) who attends the AAI annual meeting and presents an outstanding abstract in the area of immune regulation.	Up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
Lefrançois-BioLegend Memorial Award	December 19	Intended to advance the career of a trainee who attends the AAI annual meeting and presents an outstanding abstract in the area of mucosal immunology.	\$1,000 award

Travel for Techniques Awards	February 15, June 15, and October 15	Support regular and associate members in traveling to another laboratory to learn a technique. The recipient may assign the award to another AAI member in his or her lab.	Up to \$1,500 in travel reimbursement
Outreach Awards	Rolling	Support various activities such as oral and post- er presentation awards, student workshops, and career sessions at member-organized immunology meetings.	Various
