## Fellowships

<b>Careers in Immunology Fellowships</b>	<b>March 15</b>	Provide member PIs with one year of salary support for a graduate student or postdoctoral fellow in their labs.	Up to \$60,780 in salary support
<b>Intersect Fellowships for Computational Scientists and Immunologists</b>	<b>September 1</b>	Support immunology researchers and computational scientists to train in each other's discipline. PIs receive one year of salary support for a postdoctoral fellow.	Up to \$60,780 in salary support
<b>Fellowships for Career Reentry</b>	<b>September 1</b>	Provide one year of salary support to postdoctoral fellows who have taken a leave of absence of one year or more due to family-related issues, medical absences, or military obligations.	Up to \$60,780 in salary support

<b>Excellence in Mentoring Award</b>	<b>October 14</b>	Recognizes a senior scientist who has significantly influenced the professional development and careers of a new generation.	Up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the AAI annual meeting
<b>Steinman Award for Human Immunology Research</b>	<b>October 14</b>	Recognizes an individual who has made significant contributions to the understanding of immune processes underlying human disease pathogenesis, prevention, or therapy. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$5,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>BioLegend Herzenberg Award</b>	<b>October 14</b>	Recognizes an individual who has made exemplary research contributions to the field of B cell biology. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$5,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Thermo Fisher Meritorious Career Award</b>	<b>October 14</b>	Recognizes a mid-career scientist for outstanding research contributions to the field of immunology. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$10,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>BD Biosciences Investigator Award</b>	<b>October 14</b>	Recognizes an early-career investigator who has made outstanding contributions to the field of immunology. The recipient will present his or her research in an award lecture at the AAI annual meeting.	\$5,000 award and up to \$2,000 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting

<b>Laboratory Travel Grants</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Assist mid-career and senior investigators in attending the AAI annual meeting. Each grant will also support travel costs for a lab member of the recipient's selection.	Up to \$2,500 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Early Career Faculty Travel Grants</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Assist young investigators (assistant professor or equivalent) in attending the AAI annual meeting.	Up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Undergraduate Faculty Travel Grants</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Assist undergraduate faculty in attending the AAI annual meeting. Each grant will also support travel costs for an undergraduate student of the recipient's selection.	Up to \$2,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Trainee Abstract Awards</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Recognize trainee members whose first-author abstracts submitted to the AAI annual meeting are selected for presentation in block symposia.	Up to \$750 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Trainee Poster Awards</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Recognize trainee members whose first-author abstracts submitted to the AAI annual meeting are selected for poster sessions only and found to be exceptional by the AAI Abstract Programming Chairs.	Up to \$300 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Thermo Fisher Trainee Achievement Awards</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Recognize up to six trainees annually for career promise and presentation of an outstanding first-author abstract selected for oral presentation in a block symposium at the AAI annual meeting.	\$1,000 award and up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Minority Scientist Travel Awards</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Assist eligible underrepresented minority scientists, including trainees and early-career faculty members, in attending the AAI annual meeting.	Up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Pfizer-Showell Travel Award</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Recognizes the professional promise of an early-career investigator (assistant professor or equivalent) whose first-author abstract is selected for oral presentation at a block symposium at the AAI annual meeting.	Up to \$1,500 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Chambers-Thermo Fisher Scientific Memorial Award</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Intended to advance the career of an early-career scientist (assistant professor or equivalent) who attends the AAI annual meeting and presents an outstanding abstract in the area of cancer biology.	\$1,000 award

### Travel Awards and Grants for the AAI Annual Meeting

<b>Lustgarten-Thermo Fisher Scientific Memorial Award</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Intended to advance the career of a mid-career scientist (associate professor or equivalent) who attends the AAI annual meeting and presents an outstanding abstract in the area of immune regulation.	Up to \$1,250 in travel reimbursement to attend the annual meeting
<b>Lefrançois-BioLegend Memorial Award</b>	<b>December 14</b>	Intended to advance the career of a trainee who attends the AAI annual meeting and presents an outstanding abstract in the area of mucosal immunology.	\$1,000 award

### Other Awards

<b>Travel for Techniques Awards</b>	<b>February 15, June 15, and October 15</b>	Support regular and associate members in traveling to another laboratory to learn a technique. The recipient may assign the award to another AAI member in his or her lab.	Up to \$1,500 in travel reimbursement
<b>Outreach Awards</b>	<b>Rolling</b>	Support various activities such as oral and poster presentation awards, student workshops, and career sessions at member-organized immunology meetings.	Various
